Communicat nd Language

In Communication and Language, we will be exploring play trays connected to our learning theme and developing a bank of preferences so that we can make requests to play with these in class. We will also be extending our experiences through sensory play, using our personalised sensory choice boards to request activities.



In Mathematics we will be exploring themed number songs. Building on our awareness and participation in routines. Sorting objects through play. Filling and emptying in lots of play activities. Exploring size, through construction activities and small world play. We will also be exploring number toys and games.



Understanding The World

In Understanding the World, we will explore the colours and textures of winter, the countryside and the beach. We will have the sensory experience of being out and about exploring the natural environment.

Through sensory play activities and crafts, we will explore natural materials found in different environments. We will also celebrate world religion week, through fun play trays and activities.



Moving And Handling

In Moving and Handling, we will be taking part in lots of physical activity across the timetable including sensory circuits, riding bikes and playing on the playground equipment. We will be exploring movement in our PE lessons.

We will be practicing our dressing skills during P.E. Through a variety of activities and crafts we will develop or fine motor skills.

Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be growing our independence in travel around the school and joining in routines. In school, we will be developing our social skills and learning to play alongside



We will practice our fine motor skills by printing and painting to make beautiful crafts connected to our topic. and with each other, taking turns and sharing activities and spaces.

We will be listening to different rhymes, developing our favourite choices. Using instruments, we will explore making sounds.
