Our Theme



Our theme for Summer term is "Welcome to Hogwarts".

The World about Me

My Thinking and Problem Solving

In My Thinking and Problem Solving we will be working on number and place value. We will also be learning about the different units that we can measure length in. In Science, we will be grouping and classifying materials and finding out what the best material is for certain objects.

In Me and My Body, we are swimming again this first term. We will also be working on our athletic skills in throwing, jumping and running.

In Summer 2, we will be developing our rounders skills and hopefully having a summer sport rematch in Sharing Our Learning.



In My Community, we will be growing our independence in travel around the school and local community. We will be continuing to demonstrate our personal safety skills when visiting Withy Grove and Haigh Hall.



In My Creativity, we will be learning about British art, with a focus on David Hockney and his influence on the Pop Art era.
